- A. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, you must follow these guidelines:
 - 1. You must earn a minimum of 10 points from last semester's grades.
 - i. The first 4 points must be from List I (unless you are a senior applying for membership in February or May).
 - ii. The first 7 points (including 4 points described above) must be from Lists I and II or List I only.
 - iii. The remaining points may come from any List (I, II, or III).
 - 2. You must use no more than 5 courses to qualify.
 - 3. No CSF points are given for physical education classes, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assistant, courses taken on a pass/fail basis, or classes taken over the summer.
 - 4. CSF points are granted as follows:
 - i. a grade of A=3 CSF points
 - ii. a grade of B=1 CSF point.
 - 1. One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in AP, IB, or Honors courses; up to a maximum of two such points per semester.
 - iii. a grade of C=0 CSF points
 - iv. a grade of D or F in any course disqualifies you from membership at this time, even if that grade was earned in a course you cannot use to qualify for CSF (e.g. physical education).
- B. Also remember
 - 1. Semester membership is based on work done in the previous semester.
 - 2. You must reapply each semester.
 - 3. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side of this application. They are divided into Lists I, II, and III.
- C. List the courses you are using to qualify in the proper location below. (Consult the Lists on the reverse side of this application)
- D. You must staple a PowerSchool printout of last semester's report card to this application. The printout MUST contain your full name AND student ID# AND citizenship grades. You must also staple your receipt indicating payment of CSF dues (\$5) to this application.
