

STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

Students are expected to follow all school rules and regulations at every senior activity. Appropriate behavior is always expected, and regular school attendance will account for eligibility to participate in any and all senior activities. Remember senior activities, in particular graduation, are privileges. Participation in activities and the graduation ceremony can be revoked by Administration.

MID-SEMESTER GRADUATES

Students who graduate at mid-year or who are considered early grads may participate in graduation but must also attend graduation practices in May.

Participation in all graduation practices is mandatory in order to participate in the actual graduation ceremony. **NO EXCEPTIONS**. You **MUST** have your Graduation Code of Conduct signed and on file with the Activities Office in order to attend practice and graduation. You **MUST** also present a school ID card for entry at every practice. Students may be released early if practices are completed smoothly. Admission to graduation is by ticket only, and the number of tickets each senior will receive is determined by the last week in May.

REMINDER: All debts to the school must be cleared in order to participate in the ceremony.

EXPECTATIONS OF GRADUATION PARTICIPANTS

Graduation is an important and dignified ceremony, which has meaning for the graduating senior, parent, family, and Knight High School. The ceremony signifies the successful culmination of thirteen years of education. In order to assure a graduation ceremony which is meaningful for all, the following is expected of <u>all participants</u>:

- Graduates are to be courteous during the entire ceremony and are to refrain from any activity which is disruptive, distracting or dangerous. Please follow directions.
- 2. Graduates are not to carry anything with them into the ceremony which would cause a disturbance or would be considered a distraction. Caps and gowns shall not be altered or decorated in any fashion.
- 3. Any student who is under the influence of or in possession of alcohol or any other prohibited substance prior to the ceremony or who appears to be under the influence of any kind of controlled substance, **WILL NOT be allowed to participate**. All graduates are prohibited from drinking or smoking during the ceremony.
- 4. Graduates will dress appropriately for a ceremony of this nature. Examples of inappropriate dress are beach and sports clothing, thong-type sandals, jeans, t-shirts, etc. Dress code policy will be enforced. If a candidate for graduation violates any of the above behavior standards, that student will **NOT** be allowed to participate at graduation and will be asked to leave the ceremony. The student will be required to attend a parent conference with the principal the week following graduation.

GRADES

All requirements must be met before the school can certify graduation. Seniors failing to meet graduation requirements by May 29th will not be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Check with the Guidance Department in March to sign up for Adult Education. Any senior failing a required course may make it up at summer school. The diploma awarded will be for July graduation after a counselor verifies that the requirements have been met. Non-graduates should see the registrar for a transcript to enroll in Adult Summer School. Students graduating at the end of Summer School may participate in all activities except graduation and Grad-Nite.

TRANSCRIPTS

If you are planning to attend a college, university, or trade school in the fall and they are expecting you to furnish an official transcript after graduation, you will need to order your transcript on-line through **www.parchment.com**. Follow the instructions to set up an account and order your transcript. You will need a debit or credit card to pay a fee for each transcript. If you would like a flyer from this company, please see the Registrar.

CAP AND GOWN MEASUREMENTS

All seniors participating in the graduation exercises should have ordered their caps and gowns **by now**. If you have not placed your order, please go to the Activities Office for more information, or call Jostens at 818-367-2929. In the event that you are unable to purchase a cap and gown, see Ms. Danielle in the activities office for more details.

CAPS AND GOWNS

Caps and gowns will be issued during senior check-out on Monday (June 2nd). *Please press the gown.* Put your cap on firmly and forward with the short point almost between your eyebrows. Wear your tassel over your **RIGHT** eye.

Please **DO NOT** throw your caps in the air after graduation. There are many important reasons to not throw your caps in the air after graduation:

ACCESSORIES

Everyone should bring several bobby pins and a couple of safety pins for emergencies. It may be very windy, and you will need to secure your hats with bobby pins. If something breaks on your gown, you may need your safety pins. Do not chase your hat or anything else that may blow away. We will have Junior Class Ushers pick up items that are retrievable for you when possible.

You most likely will not find your cap again, and most students like to keep their personal cap as an important keepsake. Even if you could locate your personal cap, it will likely end up in the dirt and walked on before you retrieve it.

Most importantly, what goes up must come down. More than one student has lost an eye from the sharp corner of a cap hitting them. Please don't take a chance on ruining a friend's graduation, their eye, or even your own from an avoidable disaster.

The graduation gown may be yours to keep if paid for through Jostens. Take care of it.

Many graduates keep both their cap and gown as important keepsakes.

COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

All graduates are to <u>report by 4:30PM</u> to the large gym. <u>BE ON TIME!</u>
ID is required for check-in to the large gym. Caps and gowns must be worn. Girls are reminded to wear dresses or skirts and blouses and to leave purses with parents. Boys should wear suits or slacks with jacket, shirt and tie. Please do not wear sandals or white socks. **NO PHONES!** Students should leave any and all items with parents during graduation. <u>Do not bring items to carry (camera, sunglasses)</u>. There is no checkin of any items. The school will not be responsible.

Graduates are not permitted to carry anything, nor adorn their cap and gown in any way.
